- c. Creative Open Entry will change to **Experimental** category no storyline, no script, a collection of snippets, highlights camera/editing

- e. News Show Live or taped with no significant post edits or re-recording of segments
- f. Adult-assisted a new category that would allow for a percentage of adult assistance for K-5 (available to middle/high school needing modification)
- g. Next steps: There will be one more meeting of the sub-committee to finalize
